## Randolph's Winter ONEderland

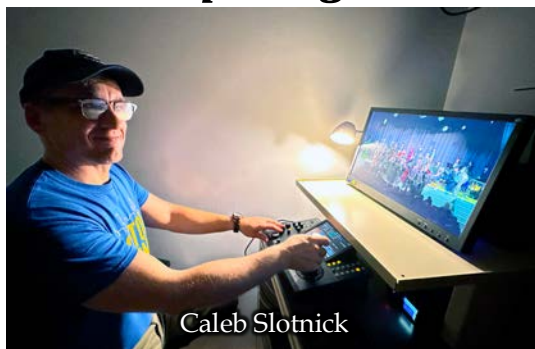
